**ACADEMIC DECATHLON COMPETITION.** The Academic Team competed in the Regional Competition earning 2 gold, 4 silver, 1 bronze and 11 honorable mention awards. The team placed 5th overall, thereby advancing to the State Competition where the team earned 1 silver, 2 bronze, and 6 honorable mention awards.

**ADVANCED PLACEMENT.** 113 total exams were administered with 88% of test takers scoring a 3 or higher for all reported scores. AP exams are scored on a scale of 1 to 5 with 5 being the highest achievable score ... 8 students were recognized as AP Scholars, 2 students were recognized as AP Scholars with Honor and 6 students were recognized as AP Scholars with Distinction. The 16 recognized scholars achieved an average score of 4.35.

**ATHLETICS.** The Girls Basketball, Ice Hockey, Golf, Softball and Boys Spring Track teams won their conference championships ... The Girls Cross Country and Softball teams won second consecutive State Sectional Championships ... The Girls Track team won a Morris County Relays Division Championship ... The Softball team won the North Jersey Group I State Championship.

**FBLA COMPETITION.** At the FBLA Regional Competition, 4 students placed 1st, 2 students placed 2nd, 5 students placed 3rd, 2 students placed 6th and 1 student placed 8th. 15 students qualified to compete at the State level where 3 students placed 1st, 1 student placed 2nd, 1 student placed 3rd, 3 students placed 4th and 1 student placed 9th. 3 students placed 5th in the Nation for Entrepreneurship and 2 students placed 7th in the Nation for Banking and Financial Systems.

**MUSIC.** 2 students were selected through competitive audition to the North Jersey Region One Symphonic Band ... 3 students were accepted to the North Jersey Junior Region Band ... 1 student was selected to the Region Jazz Ensemble ... Our Madrigal Singers performed at Carnegie Hall in New York City.

**PUBLICATIONS.** The American Scholastic Press Association has awarded Whippany Park's literary magazine ETCETERA a first place award for last year's publication entitled "With a Flicker."

**S.A.T.** Whippany Park surpassed both the state and national average with a combined score in Math, Critical Reading and Writing of 1611.

**SCHOLARS.** 6 students were named National Merit Commended Scholars and 2 students were named National Merit Finalists ... 24 students were named Presidential Academic Scholars ... 11 students achieved a perfect score of 800 on 19 different occasions on either the SAT I or SAT II ... 94% of the class of 2011 will continue formal education ... 58 students were inducted into the John Richards Chapter of the National Honor Society ... 3 students were nominated for the NJ Scholars Program and 1 student was selected as a United States Presidential Scholar ... 2 students were nominated to attend the 2011 NJ Governor's Schools.

**THEATER.** Whippany Park's musical production received a nomination for Outstanding Achievement in Lighting Design and an honorable mention for Outstanding Achievement in Graphic Design from the Papermill Playhouse Rising Star Awards.

**VISUAL ARTS.** 10 students had their photography work and 2 students had their paintings accepted into the Blackwell Street Annual Student Art Show in Morristown. 1 student was awarded a 2nd place and 1 student was awarded a 3rd place for their submissions. 5 students had their artwork selected for exhibition in the Art Start Power Art Gallery at William Paterson University. 1 student was awarded 1st place in Best Conceptual Development and 1 student was awarded an honorable mention in Digital Conceptual Development.
